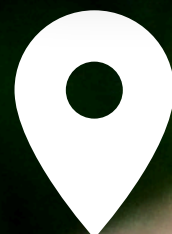

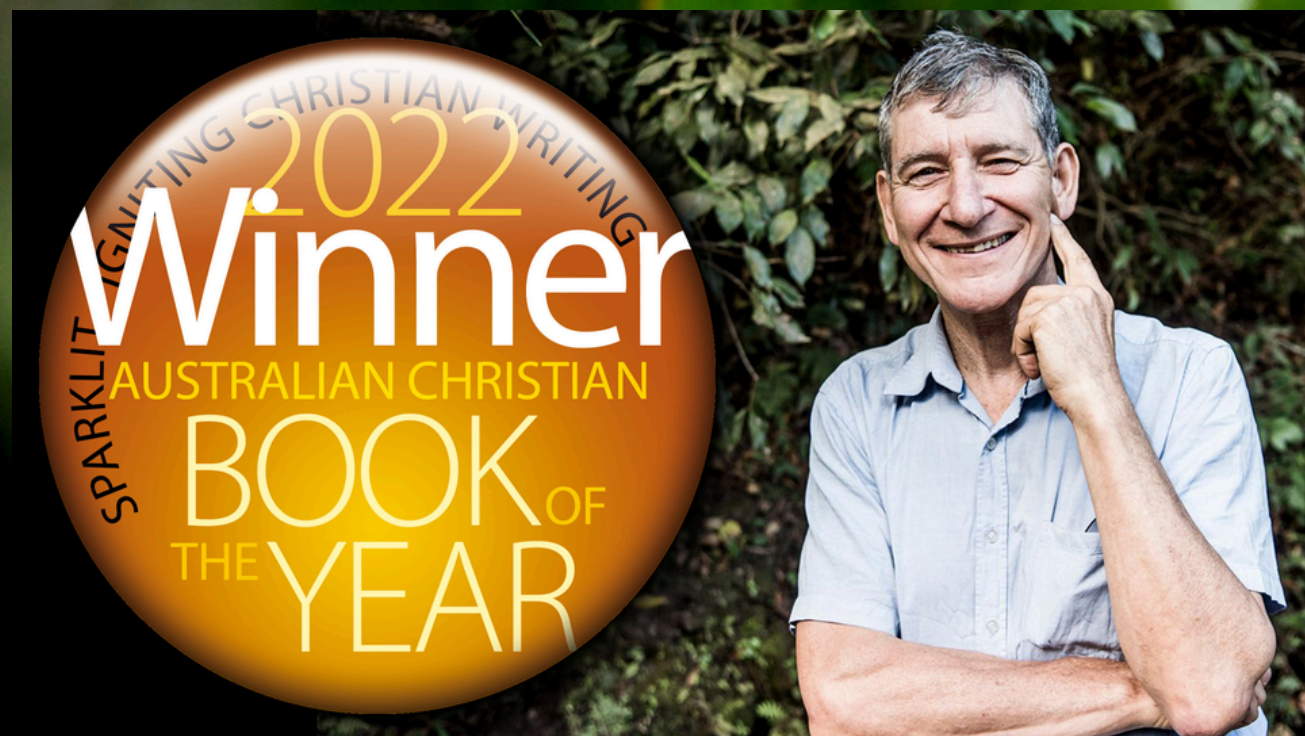

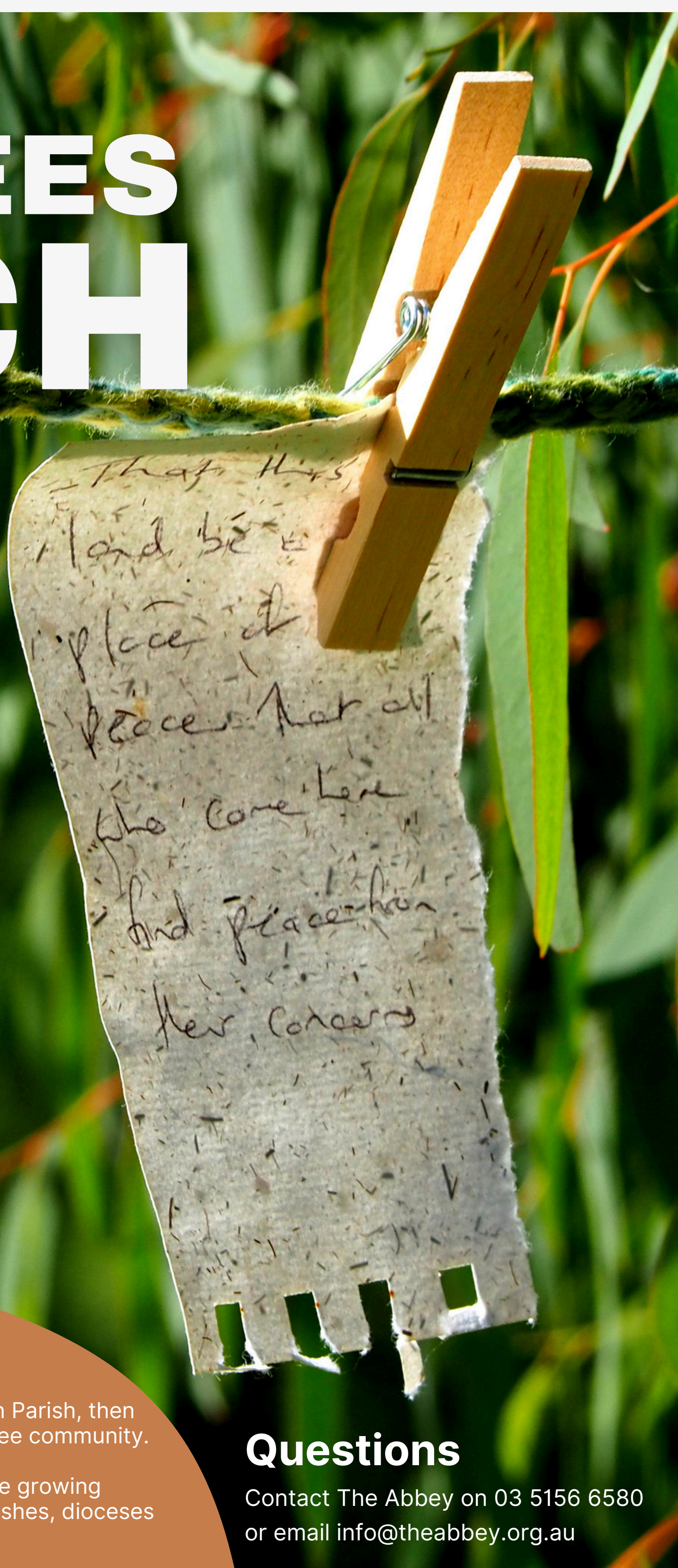
Tony Rinaudo, celebrated agronomist, and author of *The Forest Underground: Hope for a Planet in Crisis* (2022).
